

EUDF Funding Eligibility Checklist

Economic Uplift & Development Fund — use this checklist before starting a funding application.

1. Choose your programme

EUDF funds projects through four programmes. Identify which one best matches your project before applying:

Programme	Typical focus
Economic Empowerment Fund	Agriculture, technology, renewable energy, healthcare, and women-led enterprises
Skills Development Initiative	Vocational training, digital skills, education-related enterprises
Community Development Programme	Cooperative-led, community energy, and community health projects
Global Youth Empowerment Network	Youth-led ventures, applicants aged 18–29

2. Confirm your grant category and range

EUDF grants range from **€2,000 to €500,000**, sized to the scale and complexity of the project. Smaller, early-stage requests (Seed Grants, Digital Inclusion Grants, Youth Training Grants) typically fall between €2,000–€15,000. Growth-stage and larger community or infrastructure projects can range up to €500,000. Review the Funding section of the EUDF website for the full list of grant categories and indicative ranges.

3. Before you apply — checklist

- Organization or business name, and legal status if applicable
- Contact person's name, email address, and phone number
- Country and, for career applications, city of residence
- A clear project title
- A project summary of 500 words or fewer covering: what the project does, who it serves, and expected outcomes
- An estimated funding amount, within the €2,000–€500,000 range
- Confirmation that you are able to be contacted for follow-up questions during review

4. What happens after you submit

Your submission is treated as an **initial expression of interest**, not a full proposal. It is reviewed by EUDF's Grants Team against programme fit, project clarity, and available funding. If shortlisted, you will receive the official EUDF Grant Proposal Form together with instructions for the next stage of the application process. Typical review time is 4–8 weeks from submission.

5. Data & privacy

Information you submit is used only to review your application and, where relevant, to contact you about its progress. It is not sold or shared with third parties outside EUDF's review process.
